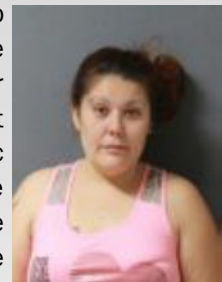
DANCO Related Arrests—

On October 29th, an Owatonna detective conducted an interview with a person who was the victim of a previous domestic assault investigation. Based upon that investigation, a Domestic Abuse No Contact Order (DANCO) was served which prohibited the suspect in the domestic assault case from being at a specific residence. During the course of the interview, the detective learned the suspect may indeed be staying at the prohibited residence. A second interview was conducted with another person who confirmed the male was staying at the prohibited address and the interviewee was told to not be truthful about the male living there. Based upon that information, a search warrant was issued for the residence. During the course of the warrant, the male suspect was found in the home and arrested. Joseph Davis, age 35, of Owatonna, has been charged with Violating a No Contact Order—a felony.

Related to the arrest of Joseph Davis, a detective followed-up with the adult female resident where Davis was arrested. The detective learned the female did not care about the court order and planned to keep Davis in her life. It was also learned that the female had punished a witness to the previous domestic assault investigation for telling the truth to the police and the punishment would remain in place until the witness told the police that their initial statement was not true. Based on the

female's actions, she was arrested and jailed. Angelica Montemayor, age 34 of Owatonna, was charged with Aiding/Abetting Violating a No Contact Order—a felony and two counts of 3rd Degree Tampering with a Witness.

Winter Parking Restrictions—

We have already had a dusting of snow and more significant snowfalls are on our horizon. With winter on our radar, we'll soon be moving into our local winter parking restrictions. Taking effect at 12:01 AM on November 15th, the ordinance restricts on-street parking on many of our streets between the hours of 12:01 AM and 12:00 PM from November 15, 2020 through March 31, 2021.
