On Monday, October 29, 2018 at approximately 8:45 PM, the Owatonna Police Department and several other police agencies initiated an operation to apprehend a wanted felon believed to be in a dwelling in Owatonna at 108 North Grove. As a search warrant was being drafted for the residence, a person believed to be the wanted felon appeared from within the residence. As officers were approaching to make the apprehension, the suspect fled on foot. A foot pursuit ensued; however, the subject was not located nor was he located in a later search of the residence. He was last seen near the 200 block of E. Pearl Street. Martin Tyler Lampkin, age 21, is currently wanted on several warrants, including 1st Degree Burglary. Lampkin was involved in home invasion robberies that took place in Owatonna in May of 2018 and is believed to be armed and dangerous. Anyone with information regarding Lampkin should contact the Owatonna Police Department at 507-774-7207. Martin Lampkin is a black male, 5'-08" and 165 lbs. He was last seen wearing a hooded gray sweatshirt. The Owatonna Police Department was assisted by the South Central Drug Investigative Unit, Cannon River Drug & Violent Offender Task Force, Steele County, Rice County, the Faribault Police Department, the Northfield Police Department and the Minnesota State Patrol/Flight Wing.
