Winter Storm Warning—On-street Parking

Due in part to the Christmas Holiday and the significant snow fall expected as a result of the projected winter storm, Owatonna residents are reminded of the City of Owatonna ordinance restricting on-street parking. The ordinance stipulates, ***“No person shall park or leave standing any vehicle on any street in the City on any day between the hours of 12:01 a.m. and 12:00 o'clock noon from November 15th through March 31st, except as hereinafter provided:”***

- On even-numbered calendar dates, vehicles may be parked on the near side of the street adjacent to lots and houses which have been assigned even numbers.
- On odd-numbered calendar dates, vehicles may be parked on the near side of the street adjacent to lots and houses which have been assigned odd numbers.
- This subdivision does not apply to any street where parking is limited to one side, to any cul-de-sac which has combined even and odd house numbers, nor to any street which has more restrictive parking requirements.
- This subdivision does not apply to street parking within a two block radius of duly constituted churches for regularly scheduled weekend services, holiday services, funerals, and weddings. Street parking is allowed one hour prior and one hour after the scheduled service times.

Please be mindful of these restrictions during the upcoming holiday seasons by informing your visiting family and guests of the correct side of the street to park their vehicles on per this ordinance so that city street crews can keep the roadways clear.

The Owatonna police Department extends our wishes for everyone to have a safe holiday season.
