

ORDINANCE NO. 1529

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 115.20 ENTITLED "DISORDERLY USE" OF CHAPTER 115 ENTITLED "RENTAL PROPERTY" OF TITLE XI ENTITLED "BUSINESS REGULATIONS" OF THE 2015 ORDINANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA REGULATING CONDUCT ON LICENSED PREMISES TO EXEMPT ITS APPLICATION IN CASES OF DOMESTIC ABUSE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 115.20 entitled "Disorderly Use" of Chapter 115 entitled "Rental Property" of Title XI entitled "Business Regulations" of the 2015 Ordinance Code of the City of Owatonna is hereby amended by adding subchapter (K) to Section 115.22 to read as follows:

(K) Consistent with Minn. Stat. § 5048.205, subd. 3, nothing in this sub-chapter:


- (1) requires an eviction after a specified number of calls by residential tenant for police or emergency assistance in response to domestic abuse or any other conduct; or
- (2) provides that calls by a residential tenant for police or emergency assistance in response to domestic abuse or any other conduct may be used to penalize or assess a fine to a landlord.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.


