AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 157 OF THE OWATONNA ZONING ORDINANCE RELATING TO ANIMAL SHELTERS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN:

<u>Section 1</u>. Ordinance No. 157 of the Owatonna Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by amending Section 157.002 (B) thereof, to read as follows with strikethroughs being deleted and underlines being additions:

ANIMAL SHELTER. An establishment supported by charitable contributions that provides a temporary home for dogs, cats, and other domesticated animals that are offered for adoption. The shelter shall not house more than 50 dogs at one time and shall not exceed a total of 100 animals at once. Such facility must located a minimum of 1000 feet from a residentially zoned property. All outdoor exercise runs are permitted provided they are enclosed on all sides by a sight obscuring fence or wall at least six feet in height.

<u>Section 2</u>. Ordinance No. 157 of the Owatonna Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by amending Section 157.022 in its entirety and amend to read as follows with strikethroughs being deleted and underlines being additions:
