ORDINANCE NO. 1547

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "APPENDIX A: FEE SCHEDULE", OF CHAPTER 35, ENTITLED "FEES AND CHARGES" OF THE 2015 ORDINANCE CODE OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA BY ADDING LICENSE FEES FOR BREWPUBS AND BREWER TAPROOMS PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE § 113.065.

Section 1. Chapter 35 entitled "Fees and Charges" of Title III entitled "Administration" of the 2015 Ordinance Code of the City of Owatonna is hereby amended by adding the following license fees:


