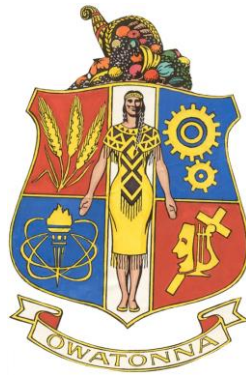

SUBJECT: Prohibit Alcohol at the new Archery Park

**Purpose:**

To amend City Ordinance 91.02 to include the Archery Range on Elm Ave. The amendment will prohibit alcohol consumption and/or possession in the park.

**Background:**

Similar to activities at Lake Kohlmier, activities at the Archery Range on Elm could be harmful to park users or guests if alcohol were consumed. Furthermore, for the City's ordinance to be enforceable by police, the Archery Range must be included.

**Budget:**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE IX OF THE 2015 CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA BY AMENDING CHAPTER 91 RELATING TO LIQUOR IN PARKS AND BEACHES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Title XI of the 2015 Code of Ordinances of the City of Owatonna is hereby amended by amending § 91.02(A) to read as follows:

(B) *Liquor in parks and beaches.* No person or persons shall display, consume or possess any intoxicating liquor, 3.2% malt liquor or intoxicating malt beverage within parking areas, roadways, sidewalks abutting or the grounds in general of Central Park, Cashman Park, ~~or~~ Kaplan's Woods Parkway and Archery Park on Elm Avenue in the city.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force after its passage and publication.
