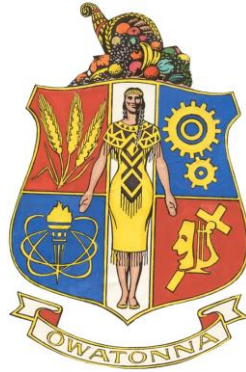

SUBJECT: Truman Avenue Project

Purpose

Requesting City Council approval of Resolution 16-21 authorizing preparation of plans and specifications for the 2020 Truman Avenue project reconstructing Truman Avenue from Havana Road to Main Street.

Background:

January 5, 2021, Council approved Resolution 178-20 accepting the feasibility report for the 2020 Truman Avenue Project. Neighborhood meetings and a public hearing were held earlier in 2020 for this project. In response to the feedback that was received, the project was postponed to the 2021 Construction Season. A neighborhood meeting was virtually on September 22, 2020. A public hearing for this improvement project took place on January 19, 2021.

Budget Impact:

The 2020 Truman Avenue Project will be paid for by State Aid, sanitary sewer, stormwater, OPU, general funds and assessments. The Engineer's estimate of total cost is currently estimated at \$3,814,878; total cost to be assessed is currently estimated at \$232,347.44.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 16 -21.

RESOLUTION NO. 16-21

A RESOLUTION RECEIVING REPORT AND ORDERING 2021 IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 132-19 of the Council adopted December 17, 2019, a report has been presented by the City Engineer and a public hearing held on January 19, 2021, with reference to the construction of proposed Improvement No. 20005, the Truman Avenue Project.

WHEREAS, ten days' mailed notice and two weeks' published notice of the hearing was given, and the hearing was held thereon on the 19th day of January 2021, at which all persons desiring to be heard were given an opportunity to be heard thereon,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Owatonna, Minnesota:

1. That the Council has considered said improvements in accordance with the report and the assessment of abutting property for all or a portion of the cost of the improvements pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429, at an estimated total cost of the improvements of \$3,814,878.

The City Engineer is hereby designated as the engineer for these improvements. He shall prepare plans and specifications for the making of such improvements.

The city council declares its official intent to reimburse itself for the costs of the improvement from the proceeds of tax-exempt bonds.
