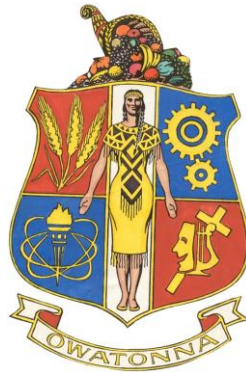

Subject: Roundabout at 18th and CSAH 48

PURPOSE:

Council to approve Resolution 29-21 setting the Terms and Conditions of the Local Road Improvement Grant for construction of a roundabout at 18th Street and CSAH 48.

BACKGROUND:

Project No. 21010 Roundabout and Trail construction at 18th St SE and CSAH 48 is a joint project between the City of Owatonna and Steele County. Construction is expected to take place in 2022. The City of Owatonna has applied for a Local Road Improvement Grant (LRIP) and the Commissioner of Transportation has given notice that funding for the project is available.

BUDGET IMPACT:

The amount of the grant has yet to be determined, but will not exceed either \$1,250,000 nor 80% of the project's final construction costs.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 29-21.

RESOLUTION NO. 29-21

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF
THE GRANT AGREEMENT TO THE STATE TRANSPORTATION FUND
LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Project No. 21010 (SAP No. TBD) Roundabout & trail construction at 18th St SE (MSAS 115) and CSAH 48 (Bixby Rd.), a joint project between the City of Owatonna and Steele County, is expected to be constructed in 2022;

WHEREAS, the City of Owatonna has applied to the Commissioner of Transportation for a grant from the Minnesota State Transportation Fund for Local Road Improvement; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Transportation has given notice that funding for this project is available; and

WHEREAS, the amount of the grant has yet to be determined but will not exceed neither \$1,250,000 nor eighty percent (80%) of the project's final construction costs.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the City of Owatonna does hereby agree to the terms and conditions of the grant consistent with Minnesota Statutes, section 174.52 and will pay any additional amount by which the cost exceeds the estimate and will return to the Minnesota State Transportation Fund any amount appropriated for the project but not required. The proper city officers are authorized to execute a grant agreement and any amendments thereto with the Commissioner of Transportation concerning the above-referenced grant.
