Purpose

City Council to approve Resolution 32-21 ordering the preparation of the 2021 North Cedar Avenue Streetscape Feasibility Report.

Background:

The 2021 North Cedar Avenue Streetscape Project consists of North Cedar Avenue Streetscape improvements focused on the three blocks between Central Park and Rose Street. The project includes increasing ADA accessibility and overall pedestrian safety, updates to the sanitary sewer and stormwater management, streetscaping and roadway reconstruction.

Budget Impact:

The project will be paid for by a combination of assessments, Sanitary Sewer Funds, Stormwater Funds and bonding.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 32-21.

RESOLUTION ORDERING PREPARATION OF REPORT ON
IMPROVEMENT ON 2021 NORTH CEDAR AVENUE STREETScape

WHEREAS, it is proposed to improve the following street as part of the 2021 North Cedar Avenue Streetscape to affect the following area:

- North Cedar Avenue between Central Park and Rose Street

and to assess the benefited property for all or a portion of the cost of the improvements, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA MINNESOTA:

That the proposed improvement, called the 2021 North Cedar Avenue Streetscape be referred to Kyle Skov, Public Works Director for the City of Owatonna, Minnesota for study and that person is instructed to report to the Council with all convenient speed advising the Council in a preliminary way as to whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvement as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels.
