We will be bringing back Robin Spande, Joan Rasmussen and Deb Praus. The Reading Room and meeting rooms will once again be available. There will no longer be capacity or time limits.

The new self-checks have been installed. We have two upstairs and two downstairs. These were purchased with CARES Act funds last year. We look forward to taking advantage of their advance functionally.

We have found out that Louanne Kaupa will not be returning to work on the garden this summer. Meredith Erickson and Director Blando met with her to go over the transition process and to see what role the Master Gardeners will be able to play.

Blando reported that the Owatonna Public Library was one of the recipients of the Parks Pass Program from the Minnesota DNR. This program allows families in need to check out a State Parks Pass for 7 days. The three passes will be shared with the Blooming Prairie library as well. We are looking at the best ways to get the passes to those who need them most.

The library will be hosting Summer Meals again this year. The setup will be the same as last year with sack lunches being grab and go.
