



DOES MY PROJECT REQUIRE A CITY GRADING/ESC PERMIT?

This document contains general information regarding procedures to follow and information required under the current Stormwater Management Code 52.00 and State/Federal NPDES regulations. ***The applicant is responsible to determine further permitting requirements for other agencies and organizations.

Projects Requiring a City Grading/ESC Permit:

- Any project with land disturbance, clearing/grubbing, stockpiling, filling, or excavating **equal to or greater than 5,000 square feet**
- All single family residential construction projects

Projects Requiring a NPDES/SDS Minnesota Pollution Control Agency Construction Stormwater Permit:

- Any project with land disturbance, clearing/grubbing, stockpiling, filling, or excavating **equal to or greater than 1 Acre**
- Any project occurring within an area covered by an active NPDES Permit must apply for **Subdivision Registration**
